

Glitter Decorations

WHY DO THIS?

Young children love to help decorate the Christmas tree and, with this activity, not only can they help decorate, they can make the decorations!

WHAT ELSE DO I LEARN?

Eye-hand coordination
Fine motor skills

WHAT DO I NEED?

- Glitter in a shaker
- Elmer's or white glue
- Styrofoam meat trays

WHAT DO I DO?

1. Let the children make a tree form design with the glue in the meat tray.
2. Sprinkle glitter over the glue, being careful to keep the glitter away from eyes.
3. Let the glue dry 24 to 48 hours.
4. Lift the decoration from the tray and attach a hanger of yarn or string.
5. Have fun decorating the tree.

Try these decorations with colored sand or another textured material.
